(September 20, 2017)—The 21st Annual Livermore Airport Open House & Air Show will offer a full day of fun for the whole family with wine tasting by Livermore Valley wineries, a fabulous display of aircraft, vintage cars, music, local vendors and an array of food options. On Saturday, October 7, from 10am to 4pm at the Livermore Municipal Airport, 20 local wineries will each pour two of their wines among displays of military, classic, experimental/homebuilt and aerobatic aircraft and vintage cars. Air Show guests also will enjoy mobile gourmet foods presented by Food Truck Mafia, activities for kids and many performances and "flybys" by:

- Renowned air show pilots, including Vicky Benzing Aerosports, Wild Thing Air Shows, Rich Perkins' Marchetti and RedFox Airshows
- Military/warbird planes
- Parachute demonstration jumps
