LIVERMORE VALLEY WINERIES HOST 10th ANNUAL BARREL TASTING WEEKEND MARCH 10-11 Fun new features to enhance popular tasting event

Livermore Valley, Calif.— A unique Painted Barrel Trail & Raffle and gourmet brunches at four wineries will add artistic flavor to the 10th annual Barrel Tasting Weekend in Livermore Valley wine country March 10 and 11. More than 35 wineries located less than an hour from San Francisco or Silicon Valley will join area breweries and distilleries to offer samples of locally produced libations from noon to 4:30 each day. Guests will have the opportunity to enjoy brunch at a winery before the tasting event starts and can also pre-purchase some of the barrel wines at a discount, a practice known as buying "futures." Many winemakers will be present to personally pour and discuss their young wines and offer delicious pairings with gourmet appetizers.

Barrel Tasting Weekend provides wine enthusiasts of all experience levels with a fun "snapshot" of how wine evolves—from grape to glass. More than a dozen varietals, including the rare Primitivo and Alicante Bouschet and ever-popular Chardonnay and Cabernet Sauvignon, will be presented for tasting across Livermore Valley.

Guests with special event wristbands and official glasses will receive samples at each participating winery, brewery and distillery. Many locations will have live music, arts and crafts vendors, discounts on bottle purchases and food available for purchase. Tickets are \$45 in advance and \$55 at the event. 1st Annual Painted Barrel Trail & Raffle

Fifteen wineries have teamed up with local artists, including scout troops and schools, to create Livermore Valley's first annual Painted Barrel Trail. A hand-painted, full-size wine barrel will be displayed in front of each participating winery starting February 1. For the six weekends leading up to Barrel Tasting Weekends, guests can follow the Painted Barrel Trail, sample wines and admire the original artwork on the barrels.

Visitors are also invited to participate in the Painted Barrel Raffle at each winery to win its one-of-a-kind barrel and a case of wine. Raffle tickets—\$20 each, or six tickets for \$100—will be sold at participating wineries and at the Livermore Valley Winegrowers Association's office starting February 1. Winners will be randomly selected and notified immediately after Barrel Tasting Weekend.
