Greenville Road wineries make for great day trip

1 Just off Greenville on Lupin Way, [el Sol Winery](#) is known for hospitality and a relaxed, informal atmosphere. The easygoing, enthusiastic owner and winemaker, Hal Liske, handcrafts el Sol wines using traditional practices to produce small lots of nontraditional varietals from around the world. Guests will discover a wide variety of affordable wines made with the skill, passion and spirit of el Sol, including sangiovese, carignane, tempranillo and barbara. Located at 8626 Lupin Way.

2 After passing Tesla Road, take a right turn onto Cedar Mountain Drive and you'll come across [Caddis Winery](#). Caddis is dedicated to the production of premier small lot wines and purchases only the best grapes from high quality vineyards. Caddis is open by appointment only, so be sure to call ahead to schedule your visit. Located at 7878 Cedar Mountain Road.

3 Heading south, you will arrive at [McGrail Vineyards and Winery](#), home of award-winning cabernet sauvignon. McGrail prides itself on being a boutique winery centered on family, friends and fellow wine lovers. They focus on creating the finest cabernet through small lot production. The lovely tasting room sits in front of the estate vineyard and hosts lively events year-round. Located at 5600 Greenville Road.

4 Just a few steps down Greenville is [3 Steves Winery](#), a boutique winery owned and operated by three friends who -- you guessed it -- are all named Steve. The winery is perched at the top of Greenville Road with stunning 360-degree views. Join a Steve for some stories while enjoying estate grown cabernet, zinfandel, chardonnay and other wines. Located at 5700 Greenville Road.

5 Tucked away off of Greenville Road you will find the cozy tasting room of [Bent Creek Winery](#). Bent Creek is dedicated to making fine wines and ports from the grapes of Livermore Valley vineyards. Their motto is "Good times start at the end of the road!" Located at 5455 Greenville Road.

6 Continuing down Greenville Road you will find the tasting rooms of [Big White House](#) and Charles R Vineyards.

Big White House is celebrating their 20th year of winemaking, specializing in handcrafted, small-lot, luxury wines of rare quality with an emphasis on Rhone-type varieties. Located at 6800 Greenville Road.

7 At the end of the street is [Charles R Vineyards](#), another family owned and operated winery in the valley. The Bartlett Family has called Livermore Valley home for more than three decades and started their production of wine in 2002. They produce small lots of handcrafted wine. Located at 8195 Crane Ridge Road.
