1 One of the newest wineries to the Livermore Valley is [Leisure Street Winery](#). This family owned winery was established in 2013 with help from one of their neighbor wineries, 3 Steves Winery. In March of 2016, Leisure Street opened its first tasting room and has been growing ever since. They feature small lot wines and their Winemaker Kelli Volpatti truly believes in the saying, "Serve no wine till it's time." Located at 503 Leisure Street.

2 Tucked away in the hills of Sunol, you can find Elliston Vineyards. [Elliston Vineyards](#) has created extraordinary hand-crafted wines for more than 125 years, with a mission to provide excellent and affordable wines. However, wine is not the only thing you will find on Elliston's grounds. The property consists of a historic mansion, lush trees that surround the grounds, and beautiful gazebos to relax under. Located at 463 Killkare Road, Sunol.

3 Also located in the rolling hills of Sunol is [Nella Terra Cellars](#), a boutique winery located on 100 acres. Nella Terra was started by the Beemiller Family in 2013. Due to the unique and cool climate of their Vineyards, Nella Terra Cellars is able to grow and produce their very own pinot noir. Nella Terra is one of the only wineries in the Livermore Valley that produces pinot noir on their property, and they take pride in growing their high-quality grapes. This beautiful hillside winery makes you feel as if you're in your own little vineyard oasis, complete with a lagoon and breathtaking views. Located at 5005 Sheridan Road, Sunol.
