



# Livermore Valley Day Guide

## Starting from Downtown Livermore

**This chain of wineries is the perfect way to continue a day of fun, after enjoying a nice lunch in Downtown Livermore.**

**1** Located on South Livermore Avenue is [Retzlaff Vineyards](#), a family operated vineyard and winery since 1983. Retzlaff Vineyards was one of the first five wineries to emerge in the Livermore Valley, and they have been flourishing ever since. All of their wines are estate bottled and are produced from their certified organic grown grapes on their property. Enjoy a picnic and a nice glass of wine under their 100-year-old pepper trees and string lights. Located at 1356 South Livermore Avenue.

**2** Continue South down South Livermore Avenue for a half mile and you'll reach [Page Mill Winery](#), a winery that originally started off in the Santa Cruz Mountains and relocated to Livermore Valley in 2004. Page Mill Winery has been producing award winning wines since 1976, with a motto of "Peace through wine, one glass at a time." Their flagship wines consist of sauvignon blanc, syrah, estate Petite sirah and GPS. Located at 1960 South Livermore Avenue.

**3** About another half mile down the road, where South Livermore Avenue turns into Tesla Road, you will come across [Concannon Vineyard](#). Founded in 1883, and home of the Concannon cabernet Clones 7 and 8, Concannon Vineyard paved the way and helped California cabernet achieve international recognition and also released "America's First Petite Sirah" varietal. Explore over 100 years of history by taking one of their many tours offered on their property. Located at 4590 Tesla Road.
