



Take a taste-and-sip stroll down Tesla Road

- 1** Begin your day by going East on Tesla Road and turn left onto Buena Vista Avenue to find [Mitchell Katz Winery](#). This popular local winery offers handcrafted, vineyard designated wines that show off the vast number of microclimates and soil variations in the historic Livermore Valley. Wine tasters enjoy a wide selection of award-winning wines with cheese and crackers. Located at 2481 Buena Vista Avenue.
- 2** Make your way back to Tesla Road heading East, and you'll quickly come across [Crooked Vine Winery](#), a family-owned and operated winery and vineyard in the heart of Livermore Valley. It's a popular spot for weddings and events -- the barrel room accommodates up to 100 guests, while the Garden Terrace with lush gardens and lawn provides a beautiful setting for up to 200. Located at 4948 Tesla Road.
- 3** Continue East on Tesla Road, then make a quick turn onto Mines Road. Travel down Mines Road for about half a mile, and you'll arrive at [Murrieta's Well](#). Here you'll find limited production wine blends and handcrafted small-batch blends from their estate. They also offer a wine and food experience that artfully crafts and pairs their wines with seasonal small bites curated by their on-site chef. Located at 3005 Mines Road.
- 4** Head back to Tesla, [The Singing Winemaker](#), and Steve Powell entertains guests most afternoons. Enjoy wines from neighbor wineries, sing a song and browse gifts in the lovely tasting room. The Singing Winemaker invites guests to celebrate truth, beauty and goodness through wine, music and art. Located at 5143 Tesla Road.
- 5** Across the courtyard is [Ehrenberg Cellars](#). Ehrenberg was started by Chris Ehrenberg in his garage and entered the commercial wine business in 2008. With the goal of breaking the mold of a typical winery, Chris is determined to make top quality, handcrafted boutique wines. They specialize in their zinfandel wines, but also serve other varietals like rose, syrah and cabernet. Located at 5143 Tesla Road.
- 6** A few doors down you can find [The Steven Kent Winery](#), which was started in 1996 with one mission: to make cabernet here in the Livermore Valley that rivals in quality the greatest red wines made anywhere in the world. Owner and winemaker Steven Kent Mirassou is a member of one of the oldest winemaking families in California. He carefully selects grapes from local vineyards to make acclaimed small-lot wines, including Lineage, which showcases the finely tuned terroir of the Ghielmetti Estate Vineyard. Located at 5443 Tesla Road.
- 7** And finally, not even a five minute walk down Tesla will lead you to [Wente Vineyards](#). Wente was founded in 1883 and is known as the country's oldest "continuously operated family-owned winery" and California's first family of chardonnay. Wente takes pride in the fact that today, 80% of all California chardonnay stems from a Wente Clone. Celebrate the history of over 100 years of winemaking and visit Wente Vineyards Estate Tasting Room at 5565 Tesla Road.
