



Livermore Valley Day Guide

The Westside Wine Trail

Explore a different part of Livermore Valley wine country with this itinerary for a great afternoon of wine tasting with a minimum of driving.

1 Housed in a historic winery, [Fenestra](#) was founded in 1976 and offers a friendly, warm welcome to all. Taste the wide variety of award-winning wines of owner Lanny Repogle and winemaker Aaron Luna, while enjoying country ambience. The picnic grounds are bordered by a seasonal creek with the vineyards in view. Located at 83 Vallecitos Road.

2 Less than a mile Northwest from Fenestra, you can find [Dante Robere Vineyards](#). Winemakers Dan Rosenberg and Bob Bossi, hence [Dante Robere](#), opened up their tasting room on Wetmore Road in 2015. Dante Robere specializes in their Estate grown syrah blend wines, Rhone varietals, stalwart varietals and other unique wines such as barbera and tempranillo. Located at 1200 Wetmore Road.

3 Less than one mile away on Wetmore Road is [Las Positas Vineyards](#), where you can enjoy award-winning wines and views of some of the oldest vineyards in Livermore Valley. Las Positas Vineyards is a family winery, wedding and event venue that produces small lots of estate-grown wines with unique character and exceptional quality. Check out their fun Movie Night series and winemaker tours offered every second and fourth Friday. Located at 1828 Wetmore Road.

4 If you continue east on Wetmore and turn left on Arroyo Road, you'll find [Cuda Ridge Wines](#) on the right. Also family-owned, Cuda Ridge does extensive blending of varietals and strives for lower-alcohol wines with intense complexity and character, traditional of the Bordeaux style. Their new facility offers a true wine country setting with a picnic area beside the estate petit verdot vineyard. Packaged picnic items are available for purchase. Located at 2400 Arroyo Road.

5 A bit further north on Arroyo Road, away from the Westside Wineries, and a right turn on Marina Avenue takes you to [Rodrigue Molyneux Winery](#). This family-owned vineyard and winery was founded by longtime Livermore residents Garry and Nancy Rodrigue. The winery specializes in cabernet sauvignon, Livermore varietals, Italian varietal wines and full-bodied blends. Taste estate-bottled wines while roaming the drought-resistant gardens or enjoy a bottle of wine with a picnic under the old shade trees. Located at 3053 Marina Avenue.
